Bill Chiang (蔣時亮)

Born in 重慶, raised in Taiwan. Came to America in 1968 and enrolled in Syracuse University with full scholarship for MSEE degree. Spent 35 years working for the Fortune 500 companies; Motorola, GTE, Bose, General Electric, and Schlumberger. He has progressively advanced from a hardware engineer to engineering manager, operations manager, VP of engineering, VP of manufacturing operations, General Manager, and finally VP of worldwide operations. Bill retired in 2005 and became an independent management consultant for various industries and businesses.



Derek Cheung (張大凱)

Born and raised in Shanghai/Hong Kong. Pursued college education in US and received PhD in EE from Stanford. Started career in Silicon Valley in 1969, then joined Rockwell Science Center (RSC) in Thousand Oaks in 1975, where he worked continuously for 32 years. Derek became President & CEO in 1997 and led the successful transformation of RSC from a corporate research lab to a for-profit high tech company, with revenue of \$136M and profit of \$21M in 2005. He engineered the sale of RSC to Teledyne in 2006 and retired in 2007. He was an Adjunct Professor at UCLA for 2 years where he initiated multiple spin-offs. He authored the award winning book 電的旅程, which is available in Chinese, English & Korean.
